

Get a travel health consultation at least 6 weeks before journey

Travellers may have concern about the health and sanitary conditions of their destinations especially when visiting rural, developing countries and it is the responsibility of travellers to obtain those information and advice from health care professionals before travel. The travel health consultation will determine the need for any vaccinations and / or antimalarial medication and identify any other medical items that the traveller may require. This kind of consultation should take place at least 6 weeks before the journey as some of the vaccines require several injections before becoming effective.

For some destinations, vaccination against yellow fever not only offers personal protection, but also serves as an entry requirement for travellers. Travellers visiting those countries should receive yellow fever vaccination at least 10 days before arrival. In Hong Kong, the vaccine is only available in our Travel Health Centres. In order to avoid unnecessary delay in receiving yellow fever vaccination, travellers are advised to make an appointment with us at least 6 weeks before travel.
